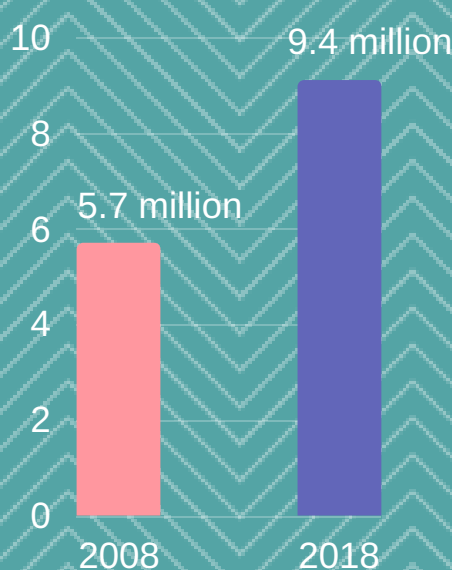




U.S. WORKING OLDER ADULTS: LABOR TRENDS
