## 44%

Non-retired adults who think their retirement saving is not on track<sup>1</sup>

## 25%

Non-retired adults who have no retirement savings or pension whatsoever<sup>2</sup>

## 60%

Non-retired adults who hold self-directed retirement savings accounts, such as a 401(k) or IRA, expressed little or no comfort with managing their investments<sup>3</sup>

## 40%

People who retired before age 62 who say poor health contributed to their retirement<sup>4</sup>
